Hobie® Kayak Pad Set Install Instructions

Tools Needed:

- Masking tape
- Razor knife
- Small roller (laminare or roller style) available at home centers
- Isopropyl Alcohol
- Clean Rags

Notes:

Do not install MarineMat if the temperature is below 60 degrees Fahrenheit. The surface must be clean and free from any oils, waxes or residue. The surface must also be completely dry in order for the adhesive to work properly. Do not attempt to pull, stretch or tug on the mats as you install. The foam has a memory and will pull itself back over time.

- 1 Completely wash and dry the entire area where your new MarineMat will be installed. Clean and wipe all areas with the isopropyl alcohol to remove any residue, change rags often so you do not spread contaminants around.
- 2 Unpack your kit and lay it out on a flat surface to allow it to return back to flat if it was rolled during packaging. At this time you should also take an inventory of all pieces and make sure nothing is damaged. Contact customer service right away if you find anything wrong.
- 3 Lay all the pieces into their proper location on the Kayak and check for fit and alignment. At this point using the masking tape you can temporarily tape the piece in place so you can ensure alignment as you install.
- 4 Score the backing paper on the first piece to be installed in the middle of the mat using your razor knife. Be careful not to cut too deep.
- 5 Continue in the same manner for all the remaining pieces. Small pieces are best if you remove all the backing at once and align the entire mat while holding just slightly above the surface.
- 6 Once all mats are installed take the roller and roll over the entire surface of all the mats using even strong pressure. Make sure to take special care around all the edges. You may even want to use your finger to apply pressure all the way around all edges.
- 7 Start enjoying your new MarineMat and look in your owner's guide or online for care and maintenance instructions.
